Risk Profile



At Interflow, safety is one of the pillars that underpins everything we do. We are committed to continual improvement in the way we manage our Operations, Environmental and Safety obligations.



A key initiative in Interflow's Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) Strategy is to develop a well-structured, dynamic, informed, HSE Risk Profile to provide Interflow's leaders with the accurate information they need to make and promote true risk-based decision making, effectively allocating resources to the areas of greatest risk, at all levels of the organisation.

The final deliverable of this initiative is the HSE Risk Profile dashboard, that is influenced by a wide volume of data. The HSE Risk profile is;

- Mapped against Interflow's known HSE Risk Events
- Dynamic and subject to change based on a number of influences eg audits, assurance activities, incidents etc
- Improving the capability and understanding of HSE Risk amongst the leaders of Interflow
- Driving a positive shift in risk and HSE maturity – in line with a 'proactive' position on the Hudson Maturity model
- Driving more informed HSE decision making at all levels of the organisation
- Influencing HSE and wider business strategy
- Identifying, collecting, consolidating, cleansing and analysing existing and new HSE data

Having the best possible understanding of the HSE risks Interflow is exposed to enables effective decision making, reduces uncertainty against business objectives and acts as a mechanism for genuine social problem solving, along with complimenting a number of other strategic initiatives.
