**HSE Risk Events** 



At Interflow, safety is one of the pillars that underpins everything we do. We are committed to continual improvement in the way we manage our Operations, Environmental and Safety obligations.









A successful risk and assurance framework and management system recognises that Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) 'risk events' are far from static. Exposure to risks and the effectiveness of our control measures may alter over time with causal or contributing factors always having a varying level of influence.

At Interflow, we have identified 45 'HSE Risk Events' that we use to perform an assessment of our overall position and performance of HSE. The evaluation of these risk events is then used as a key data set to inform our HSE Risk Profile. We repeat these assessments periodically to better understand the influences of our risks and the performance of our controls. This approach allows us to effectively reduce the uncertainty of HSE risk that the organisation is exposed to.

Having a deep understanding of our risk events assists our organisation to have genuine risk-based decision making, prioritisation of risks/controls and effective allocation of resources.
